

CAPTURED KIDS CAMP – JUNE 7th – 10th CAMP RULES

1. Every camper and adult that comes to camp will be considered to agree to these rules and agree to abide by them.
2. No camper or chaperone will leave the campgrounds without permission from the camp director.
3. ALL INJURIES must be reported immediately to the camp nurse.
4. Boys will not enter girls cabins and girls will not enter boys cabins.
5. Absolutely NO P.D.A. (Public Display of Affection).
6. No Boy / Girl will be permitted to be alone together at any time.
7. RESTRICTIONS:
No food or drinks in the worship center.
All litter will be put in trash cans.
Vehicles must remain parked after arriving at camp.
Electronic devices will not be used during worship, group times, or any organized event.
no smoking, chewing tobacco, alcoholic beverages, or drugs will be tolerated. Absolutely Water
balloons, water guns and shaving cream may not be brought by campers.
No "cut-offs" may be worn in the swimming pool.
There will be no swimming except during designated swim times when a lifeguard is on duty.
8. DRESS CODE:
Everyone must be modestly dressed.
Only shorts no shorter than six inches above the center of the knee will be allowed. No part of the bra needs to be seen and no cleavage needs to be exposed. Belly should be covered at all times even if your hands are raised. Boys, no underwear showing above pants, no shirts that are split down the side.
Cover ups are to be worn to and from the pool. If you wear a 2 piece swim suit you MUST wear a cover up in the pool.
9. All adult chaperones are responsible for the enforcement of all rules.

Please distribute these camp rules to all students and adults who attend with your group. These rules do not have to be returned to the camp.

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
